HRPP Toolkit Go-Live

As of July 14, 2023 the <u>HRPP Toolkit</u> is **live** and available to view by the research community. The HRPP toolkit is a comprehensive set of workflows, standard operating procedures, checklists, worksheets, and templates designed to address the management of IRB submissions through the study lifecycle and includes protocol templates that help research teams develop compliant protocols.
